Meeting Times & Logistics

Please arrive by your scheduled meet time

Before Launch Your Guide will:

- Process your paperwork
- Fit you with a PFD
(Personal Floatation Device)
- Provide you with a wetsuit and
nylon splash top if necessary
- Give a safety talk about the river, raft,
and gear
- Teach you paddle commands

Before Launch You will:

- Complete paperwork for all
family members
- Lock all valuables, dry clothes, and towels
in your vehicle
- Give your keys to the Guide to place in
the secure lock box

Trip Information:

- Half-day Lunch:** Not provided
- One-day Lunch:** Lunch is provided
- Trip time:** Depending on water level Half
-day: 4-5hr / One-day: 6-7hr
- Trip back to vehicle:** 30 min - 1 hr
- Please** return PFD, splash top, and wet-
suit to your Guide, so we can clean and
prepare for the next trip

We Provide:

- Professionally trained guides
- Rafts, Paddles, & Helmets
- PFD's (Personal Floatation Device)
- Wet suit and nylon splash jacket
- One-day trips:** Lunch along the river
including water and lemonade
- Toilet facilities at boat launch and at lunch
- First Aid - All guides are certified in First
Aid and CPR



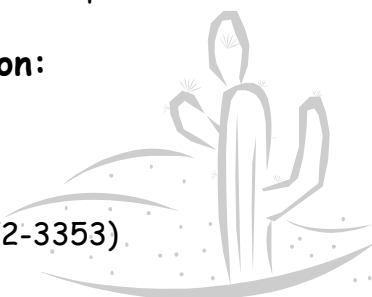
You Must Bring:

- Water bottle filled with water- **IMPORTANT!**
(One-day can refill at lunch.)
- Short or long sleeve top (synthetic or quick-
dry fabrics)
- Bathing suit and/or nylon shorts or pants
- Sunscreen
- Lip ointment
- Outdoor sandals with ankle strap OR
non-slip sneakers or booties
- Neoprene or wool socks (for cool days)
- Sun glasses with strap
- Hat with brim and strap
- Camera with lots of film- **WATERPROOF!!!**
- Change of clothes for drive home
- Prescribed medication

Note: *Alcoholic beverages are **NOT** allowed on the river. For safety and liability reasons, intoxicated passengers will not be allowed to participate in the river trip.*

The Upper Salt River is on the Apache reservation. Please respect their land and people while visiting.



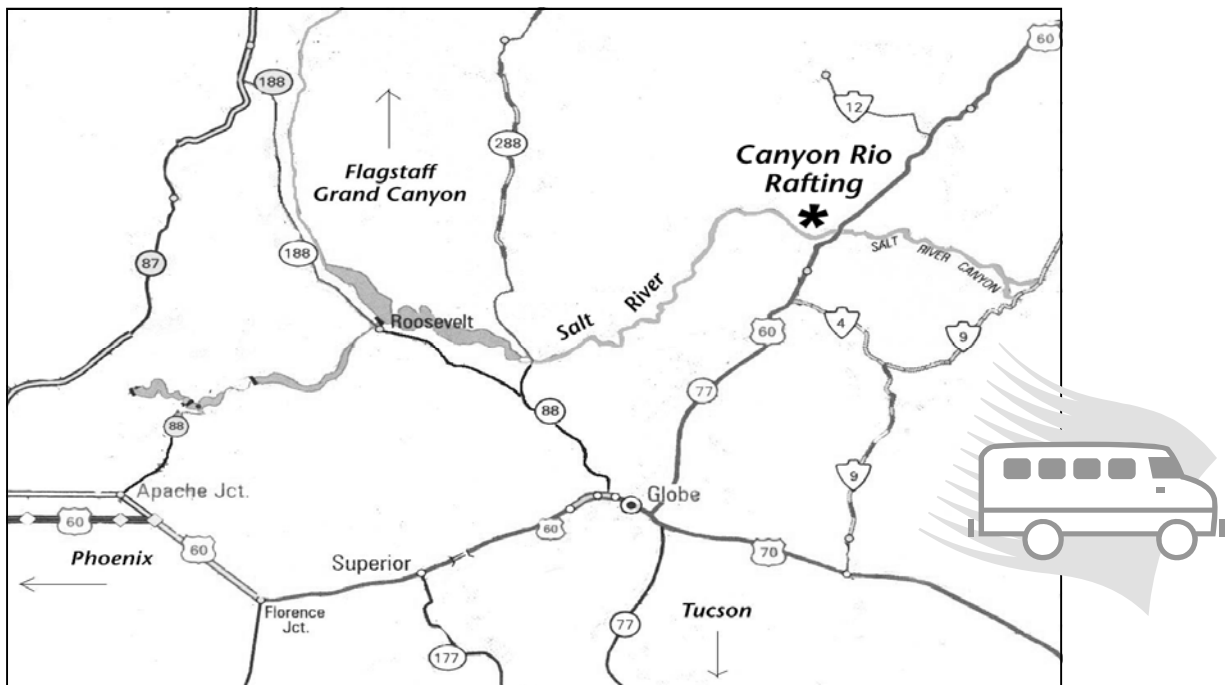


Canyon RIO Rafting Upper Salt River General Information & Driving Directions

From Phoenix: Take Highway 60 East to Globe. Drive North on Hwy 60 until you cross over the Salt River Canyon Bridge, just after you cross over the bridge, take the first left onto a gravel road (there will be signs that say Canyon Rio Rafting) drive down the gravel road to the first parking lot on the right. Driving time: 2-3 hours depending on where in Phoenix you live.

From Tucson: Take Highway 77 North to Globe. Drive North on Hwy 60 until you cross over the Salt River Canyon Bridge. Just after you cross the bridge, take the first Left onto a gravel road (there will be signs that say Canyon Rio Rafting) drive down the gravel road to the first parking lot on the right. Driving time: 2.5 hours

From Flagstaff: Drive East on I-40 to Holbrook. Go South on Hwy 77 to Showlow. Take a Right turn onto Hwy 60 South. Before you cross over the Salt River Canyon bridge, take a Right onto a gravel road (there will be signs that say Canyon Rio Rafting) drive down the gravel road to the first parking lot on the right. Driving time: 3.5 hours



Payment and Cancellation Policies

Payment: Full payment is required upon registration

Cancellations:

- With 8+ days notice, 75% of trip cost will be refunded
- With 3 - 7 days notice, 25% of trip cost will be refunded, may reschedule for *this season*
- 3 days notice or less, NO REFUND will be offered
- \$25 fee to reschedule, per group
- All payment will be refunded or client may reschedule if we are forced to cancel a trip due to weather, water levels, or low enrollment.
